Free Clean Up Week (For Residents Inside Town Limits Only) April 17–21, 2023

The Town of Stoneville Public Works Department will provide roadside pickup for the accepted items below from Monday, April 17th – Friday, April 21st. Residents may start placing items at the curb on Monday April 10th. All items for pick-up must be at the curb by 6:00AM on April 17th. Each street will only be serviced once.

Due to changes made by the Rockingham County landfill, the Town will only pick-up the following items: Free Clean Up Week Program!

Items Accepted

- Regular Residential Solid Waste in bags only.
- Household Furniture, Mattresses and Box Springs.
- Refrigerators/Freezers

Items Not Accepted *

- Loose Trash, Dead Animals, Rock, Glass, Tires
- Clothing or shoes
- Yard Waste
- Wood or Lumber, Construction and Demolition Debris, Building Materials, Shingles, Doors, Windows, Siding (any material or waste recognized as commercial waste)
- Auto Parts, Metal, Motors, Lawn Mowers, Gas Tanks, Pressurized Containers, Liquids, Batteries, Equipment Containing Gas/Oil
- Paint, Cement, Chemicals, Medical Waste
- Electronics, TV's, Computers, Printers, etc.
- Items in boxes

*If any of the non-accepted items are placed out for pickup, they will be left for you to dispose of by April 26th at 5:00PM. These items also <u>will not</u> be considered as a bulk item pick up through Waste Management.

Things to Remember

- Water bills are mailed out on the 1st of each month. After 5:00pm on the 20th of the month, a 10% late fee will be charged. If the bill is not paid by 5:00pm on the 27th of the month, a \$50.00 delinquent fee will be charged and water service will be disconnected.
- Public works will collect brush and limbs from the roadside tentatively the 2nd week of the month, but they will not collect leaves and other clippings that are not in bags. Leaf collection is provided once a year by the Town of Stoneville. Please call the Town Hall when brush is put at the roadside to schedule a pickup.
- We do realize that potholes have become an issue on certain town roads. Please call the Town Hall to report potholes so that repairs can be scheduled for the 2nd week of the month.
- Waste Management will not pick up trash containers that are 'contaminated'. Make sure the lid is closed and all items are inside the container.
