REQUEST FOR TOWING SERVICE PARTNERS

The Town of Stoneville is seeking qualified local towing companies to partner with our Code Enforcement program for the removal of abandoned, nuisance, and junked motor vehicles within the town limits.

The Town of Stoneville is inviting local towing operators to work with our Code Enforcement Officer on an as-needed, rotating basis to remove abandoned and junked vehicles in accordance with Town ordinances and North Carolina law. Contractors must have appropriate towing equipment, maintain comprehensive automobile and general liability insurance, and operate a secure storage or impound lot suitable for holding vehicles removed from private or public property.

Participating towing companies will be responsible for the towing, storage, fee collection, and final disposition of vehicles in accordance with the Town of Stoneville's ordinances governing abandoned and junked vehicles. Contractors must also maintain appropriate records and provide a location accessible to vehicle owners for reclaiming vehicles during normal business hours.
