

How to apply

Submit an application

Attend six meetings and participate as directed by the Officer In Charge (OIC)

After attendance of six meetings, applicant will be excused from the meeting room while members discuss opinions of acceptance.

New members shall serve a 180 day probation

Once the probation period is complete the decision to retain or dismiss the applicant will be made
