What is expected of you

Partake in training and education to obtain North Carolina Firefighter Certification within two years of joining the department at no cost

- Obtain Incident Command System Certification on-line at no cost
- Have a valid NC drivers license
- Conduct oneself in a professional manner at all times
- Be respectful and courteous
- Must be 18 years of age and of sound mind and body
- Expect to make a difference

How to apply

- Submit an application
- Attend six meetings and participate as directed by the Officer In Charge (OIC)

After attendance of six meetings, applicant will be excused from the meeting room while members discuss opinions of acceptance.

New members shall serve a 180 day probation

Once the probation period is complete the decision to retain or dismiss the applicant will be made
