We are moving. Stoneville Town Hall will be moving February 11, 2022 to our new location at 107 S. Henry Street (formerly Carter Bank and Trust). We will be closing the office at 12:00 p.m. Friday the 11th to complete this move. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause. However, for our equipment to be moved and restarted, so our staff be properly prepared to serve you on Monday, February 14, 2022 this could not be avoided. The Mayor, Council and Administrative staff of the Town continue to work to improve the safety of our citizens, employees and visitors. In doing so, this building was remodeled and designed to protect all individuals and reduce the possibility of contracting Coronavirus (Covid-19), while conducting business in the Municipal Building. Funding for these renovations was provided by the American Rescue Plan. Everything we have done, was done to better serve and protect you our citizens, guest and employees. To better serve you a drive-thru window was added. If for some reason you don't feel like parking and coming into the building, you may conduct business from the comfort of your vehicle. Whether you choose to come in the building or be served at the drive- thru window, we look forward to seeing you. Also, our office now opens at 8:00 a.m. rather than 8:30 a.m.

We also are beginning a new program for Senior and/or Handicap citizens. If you would like, a town employee will be contacting you daily to be assured all is well with you. Citizens may contact town personnel by phone or stop by the office to provide the information required for this program to be effective and start receiving your daily call. This hopefully will reduce and eliminate the possibility of anyone having an unreported problem without having someone having a reason to believe there is an issue and taking steps to resolve that issue.

Water Billing and Cut Off Dates

Effective February 1, 2022 the cutoff date will be the 27th of each month. Late fees will still be applied on the 20th of each month. Your bill must be paid in full by the 27th of each month to avoid delinquent fees and disconnection. Please contact Town Hall if you have any questions.
